

# Show Rules

1. ADGA Rules will Govern
2. The base date of determining the age of the animal is the date that the animal is being shown.
3. The original registration certificate is required for all animals 6 months of age or older. This MUST be shown to the committee before the start of the show.
4. Animals under 6 months of age may be shown with either an original registration or a stamped duplicate application by the ADGA office.
5. All out of state animals are required by Wisconsin to have an Interstate Health Certificate. All animals must be enrolled in the Scrapie program. Proof of enrollment will be checked. If an animal shows signs of illness or infectious disease, including lesions, abscesses, (balding or draining), sore mouth, ringworm, pinkeye, etc. The entire herd will be barred from the show ring and the fairgrounds. ALL goats will be examined before the start of show. If there is a question about the health of an animal, a veterinarian will be called at the owners expense. Please check your animals carefully.
6. Order of the show shall be as follows: Showmanship Classes at 8:30 (SATURDAY ONLY) followed by Milking Does, Junior Does, and Bucks (BUCKS ARE SHOWN IN BOTH RINGS SATURDAY ONLY) Dustin's ring will be ring 1. Todd's ring will be Ring 2.
7. There will be no pre-show milk out.
8. All animals are shown at the owner's risk. Stateline Goat Association or the Fairgrounds cannot be responsible for loss, damage or accident to any person, property or animals at the fairgrounds.
9. Exhibitors shall furnish their own feed and bedding. No straw bedding is allowed in the HOG Barn by order of the Fire Department. The sheep barn must be filled prior to using the HOG Barn. Shavings will be for sale \$6.00 per bag.
10. Awards will be given.
11. ALL EXHIBITORS are obliged to pay pen fees- ONE TIME ONLY. Pens accommodate approximately 3 adults or 6 kids. Pen fee is \$4.00 per pen. Pens will be assigned on a first come first serve basis. NO REFUNDS after June 1, 2008. NO EXCEPTIONS.
12. All 4-H and FFA Members may show 1 project animal without being subject to entry fees ONLY IF THIS ANIMAL IS PRE-REGISTERED (PEN FEES STILL APPLY)
13. Permanent Champion is to be indicated on papers for Champion Challenge class.
14. No entries will be accepted unless accompanied by a check or money order for the appropriate amount.
15. During judging, all papers will be checked and the Official Show Report will be signed before the next show report is started.
16. Doe show: The junior and senior shows **are** separately sanctioned
17. Buck show: the junior and senior shows **are not** separately sanctioned
18. NO GOATS BY OR NEAR BLEACHERS!!!!!! USE HOLDING PENS OR OTHER DESIGNATED AREAS!!
19. Absolutely NO DOGS in show ring area or in barns during show.
20. Ring 1 will not stop for any reason. Please have handlers available. Showing in ring 2 is not an exception.
21. Entry fees are as follows: \$3.50 per animal per ring, per day IF the entry form is postmarked before May 27, 2008. For all entries postmarked after May 27, 2008, the entry fees will be \$4.50 per animal, per ring, per day.
22. For all entries over the 10<sup>th</sup> goat, there will be a \$0.50 price reduction if the entry form is postmarked by May 27, 2008. The reduction is ONLY on the entries over 10 goats.
